SANITARY NAPKIN AWARENESS AND DISTRIBUTION

Save the Life Charitable Trust organized menstrual hygiene awareness programs to educate adolescent girls and women about safe, healthy, and dignified menstrual practices. The sessions addressed myths, taboos, and health risks associated with poor hygiene, while promoting confidence and self-care. Along with awareness activities, free sanitary napkins were distributed to women and girls from economically weaker sections to ensure regular access to hygienic menstrual products. This initiative helped improve health awareness, reduce school absenteeism among girls, and encourage open conversations around menstrual health within communities.

DIGITAL TRAINING TOOLS

Save the Life Charitable Trust implemented digital training tools to strengthen digital literacy and practical skills among youth and community members. The program provided basic computer education, smartphone usage guidance, and exposure to online platforms for learning, communication, and services. Participants were trained to access digital resources related to education, government schemes, health information, and employment opportunities. This initiative helped bridge the digital divide, improved confidence in using technology, and empowered beneficiaries to adapt to a digitally driven society and enhance their livelihood prospects.

WOMEN'S SKILL PROGRAMS

Save the Life Charitable Trust implemented Women's Skill Programs to promote economic independence and social empowerment among women from underserved communities. Participants received hands-on training, guidance on small business practices, and awareness about savings and self-help opportunities. VOCATIONAL COURSES FOR YOUTH






FUTURE ROADMAP


